These seminar weeks, held once every three months, are conducted at UNLV's Singapore or Macao home locations. One of these seminar weeks will be jointly conducted at UNLV's Main Campus in Las Vegas for all MHA Singapore and Macao students. It allows students to conduct a real time industry research or operational project. As an added option, students can also choose to spend one of their remaining seminar weeks at the other home location.

 and on-site intensive one-week seminar classroom learning. For 1st month, students will study and research the assigned topic based on the material provided by their professors online. For 2nd month, students continue their studies and attend an
intensive one week seminar in Macao that will present current industry trends, best practices, examine management theories, and provide instructions needed for class projects.
 Students can expect to work on both individual and group projects. As the module closes, students finish their studies, assignments, final projects, and are given a 2-week reprieve before the next module begins.

Admission and application

For international applicants

Applicants who do not have American citizenship are considered as international applicants. International applicants need to have:

TOEFL score of minimum 600 (CBT 250 or IBT 100) or IELTS score of minimum 7.0. Applicants fulfilling any of the following can be exempt from this document:

- native language is English;
- citizens of an English speaking nation;
- undergraduate degree was conducted in English.

International students in the MHA Macao program will be required to submit medical examination report upon acceptance for student visa application.

International students in the MHA Macao program who wish to spend a seminar week at the Singapore Campus will be required to provide proof of medical examination on HIV and Tuberculosis for student visa generation prior to their travel to Singapore.
